This way, each group would consist of very strong, strong, medium and weak teams. The groups will play their matches periodically. For example, all fifteen teams in Group 1 will play against each other in a country of one of the teams of the group chosen as the host. The team that obtains the highest score in each group will reach the final stage as the group leader, gaining the right to reach the main competitions of the World Cup in a more deserving and professional manner.
